TWO RESTAURANTS, TWO BARS AND A ROOF TERRACE OVERLOOKING THE SEA

The restaurant, «Récif» (before known as «La Terrasse»), one Michelin star, on the roof terrace of the Les Roches Rouges overlooks the sea, from which the Chef, José Bailly, naturally draws his inspiration to offer dinner guests refined Mediterranean dishes, which change according that morning's catch delivered by sea, at foot of the hotel. A second hotel restaurant «La Plage» serves an authentic, simple, generous Mediterranean menu. The latter has its own bar with its own atmosphere. During the day, on the beach, by the waterside, a second "beach hut" bar serves cocktails and light meals to enjoy at all hours or as you watch the sun sink slowly into the sea.

The hotel benefits from two swimming pools: a natural seawater measuring almost 30 metres long cut into the coastal rock and a swimming lane.
