Uzès

Succumb to charm and authenticity. Discover the rich history of its ducal château – both stern fortification and a stately palace, spanning eight centuries of art and history. Experience the dignified wealth-flaunting stone façades of the Renaissance town built by its prosperous 16th century bourgeoisie. Don't forget to visit the Haribo museum!

Le Pont du Gard

Registered for 30 years on the heritage of the UNESCO. This majestic monument impresses even today by exceptional architecture.

Anduze

Since the XVIIth century, Anduze has been the unchallenged pottery capital of the Cévennes. First created in 1610, the Anduze vase is known all over the world. Anduze is also the starting point for an old steam train which takes you to the Bambouseraie (bamboo forest) and to Saint Jean du Gard

La Bambouseraie

We can make a stop for the Bamboo plantation, the unique garden in Europe. The park shelters more than 150 varieties of bamboo, and a big diversity of exotic plants and remarkable trees.

Montpellier & le Pic Saint Loup

Ambrussum

Ambrussum, the oppidum is a walled Gallic town dating back to the 4th century BC with its gallo-roman remains. The rempart, the oldest remnant is visible on the hill. The stone paved road was built during the 1st century AD. The museum's permanent exhibition allows you to discover the history and wealth of Ambrussum.

Viavino

The oenotouristique Pole Viavino is a space of discovery for all the flavors and the flavors(perfumes) of the South. Studios(workshops) of the taste are organized for children and adults. An open-air theater welcomes shows(entertainments) all summer long. The herbs garden invites in the stroll and the room of the country(soil) is a surprise with the diffusers of scents. Aigues-Mortes

Built at the peak of Gothic architecture, the fortifications of Aigues-Mortes is a remarkably well-preserved military structure. The ribbed vaults on the carved capitals, the gargoyles, the refined decor of the Tower of Constance, in contrast to the power of the defensive system of the curtain walls. From the ramparts or from the dungeons' terrace, you will discover a breath-taking sight on the Camargue and the salt marshes whose colours alternate between blue and purple.
